Class	Assignment
Reading	Read your AR book for 15-20 minutes. On a sheet of paper, record the name of your book, and the pages numbers you read.
Language Arts	After reading your AR book, K-2 students should draw a picture depicting what they read and one sentence telling what they story was about. 3-5 students should write a paragraph, (following the way they write their weekly paragraphs), include a topic sentence, 3 details and a conclusion sentence about what you read. This will be for a grade, so check for capital letters, punctuation and spelling.
Spelling	Write your spelling words three times each. If you cannot find your list, contact Mrs. Albrecht.
Math	K-2 students should practice addition and subtraction facts. 3rd-5th should practice multiplication facts. Parents can write facts on a sheet of paper for you to complete and return, or if you practice with flashcards or on the computer, have a parent write and note and sign it.
K-4 General	Most of my students participate in their grade level classrooms for some or all of their academic instruction. Distant learning packets have not been sent home yet, but check classroom teacher page to see what has been assigned for today.
