

Dear Friends and Neighbors of Flanagan-Cornell Unit 74 Schools,

Beginning Monday, September 28th, at 7 am., we will have some work done on our school parking lot. There will be milling down the old parking lot (High School end) and resurfacing with asphalt. We will have some different parking in designated areas around the school facility for our Teachers, guests, and student-drivers, as well as the possibility of different drop-off and pick up areas of our students by parents. No one will be allowed to drive or walk across this area for the week.

We expect the project to last throughout the week with Friday, October 2nd, the expected completion date. One thing for certain, the milling and brush work will cause A LOT OF DUST. Obviously, this could get on your vehicle. It will be up to you where you park, but I would share that it is important that you WASH this dust off, do not just wipe it off - it can/will scratch the paint if you simply wipe it off. Also, when this is occurring, I am suggesting all windows and doors be closed. It won't be dusty every day, but it is the first of the process and will take a couple of days for the removal work.

Please also be aware that Student Drop Off and Pick-Up Points will now be in one of three places and **you may choose which one you prefer with the exception of Pre-K students.**

1. ORANGE ZONE - Corner of Webster St. and Douglas St.
2. BLACK ZONE - The Gate located on the North side of the Football Field Fence at the Ball Field Parking Lot. All high school students who drive must park in the baseball/softball field parking lot.
3. WHITE ZONE - Cross the Wooden Bridge off of Primrose St. located on street East of Transportation Shed (Bus Garage). All Pre-K students will drop off and pick up in the white zone.
